Seaman Band Booster Minutes
September 2, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by Randy Perkins, President. Also in attendance were Gregg Bahr, VP, Cindy Mullinix, Treasurer and Beth Harrison, Secretary.

Approximately 25 parents were present.

Minutes

Perkins called for corrections to the August 12, 2010 minutes. Hearing none, it was moved and seconded to approve the minutes as presented.

Treasurer Report

Mullinix presented the treasurer's report. The current bank balance as of August 31, 2010 is \$22,457.81. A motion was made and seconded to approve the treasurer's report. A detailed report was provided to everyone in attendance.

Student Band Account

New York

Currently there are 184 students signed up to go to New York. Each student will receive a sweatshirt and music at no cost from the sponsoring organization in New York.

Committee Reports:

BBQ/Auction

Perkins shared that we would be selecting a new date for the BBQ/Auction because of the scheduled KU/K-State game. Seago will talk with Stahly about securing March 5 and if that date is not feasible will ask for January 15 or March 5.

Duck Race

Yadon discussed the specifics of the fundraiser. The total profits per duck are 50% with the other half of the proceeds going to Sertoma. All proceeds will go directly to support the bus transportation to New York. There will be an opportunity for individuals to buy a duck at the upcoming football game on Friday, September 3. A table will be setup at each of the gates. If you are available to help on Friday please contact her. In addition, Cindy Stover will be selling duck cookies inside the concessions area. Cookies will also be sold at the duck race. Please contact Cindy if you would like to help on Saturday.

Other Fundraisers

Schlossman reported on the following:

The next scheduled committee meeting is set for Wednesday, September 8 at Reeds Bar & Grille at 6:30 pm. Chili's Bar & Grill fundraiser raised \$200. Information was shared on McBand Nite at McDonald's in Hunter's Ridge. It is scheduled for Wednesday, October 6 from 4 – 8 pm. Perkins will ask for approval from Stahly. McDonald's would like for the band boosters to sell Baker Dozen Cookie gift cards for \$5.00 as part of the McBand Nite. It was decided that we would not ask the students to be responsible for this task. We will sell the tickets during the McBand Nite. Tip jars will be available at the drive thru and in the lobby. Seago will request some of the band students to play music during the event. Schlossman will work with Seago on getting volunteers to work at McBand Nite. Sponsors going on the New York trip will be asked to work the event.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the McBand Nite fundraiser at McDonald's in Hunter's Ridge on October 6, 2010.

Fireworks

Tatum-Haskell reported that the band students received \$4,700 to be divided between the students who worked or gave out discount coupons that were redeemed for fireworks.

VFW Donation

S. Colhouer reported that the drum majors would be presented with a \$300 check from the VFW (men)/Women's Auxiliary on September 14. The check will be used to assist with transportation cost.

Band Website

Christensen shared with everyone that the band handbook has been added to the website.

Old Business:

Potawatomi Tribe Grant

S. Colhouer sent the grant to the Potawatomi Tribe asking for \$10,000. We won't know if we will receive any grant money until the end of September.

Sales at Football Games

Perkins reported that the band boosters are limited to the number of times we can have fundraisers at the football games. It has been approved for us to sell ducks and cookies at the upcoming football game.

Scholarships for New York Trip

Bahr reported that it was approved for the band boosters to ask for donations at the upcoming September 24 football game (Homecoming) to help raise money for the scholarship fund.

It was suggested that we raise \$2,000 to help send band students to New York and if we were unable to do so that the band boosters would consider donating the rest. This discussion was tabled until the October 7 meeting.

New Business

KANSAS Tax Guide for Schools and Educational Institutions

Perkins reported that it has been brought to his attention that the band boosters might need to request their own tax identification number. In addition, the boosters will need to possibly start charging tax on items they sell, file tax returns, file reports etc. To help clarify this Bahr will discuss with Fred Patton what the options are and provide him with a copy of the documents the boosters have received. Items we might be excluded from paying tax on are cash donations, donated items, charging for a meal (suggested donation).

Questions/Concerns/Comments

Tatum-Haskell suggested that we consider how the band boosters can help the Fine Arts Booster Club. Harrison will email out the list of volunteer opportunities with the next band booster update.
